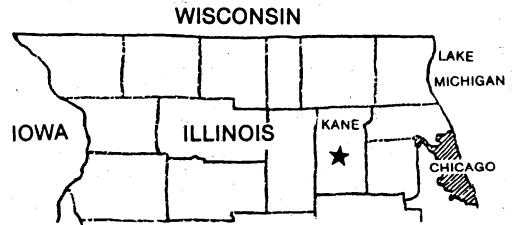

12 Noon: Lunch available

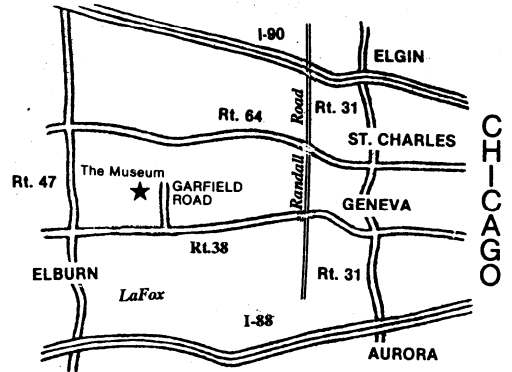


Garfield Farm is located 40 miles west of Chicago in Kane County, 5 miles west of Geneva on Rt. 38 and Garfield Road.
